**Special features of the course include:**

#### Assessment

The coursework unit/personal study (60% of total marks each) and the controlled test (40%) are centre assessed and externally moderated. As part of this assessment candidates need to demonstrate that they can:-

- \* sustain and fully explore a study from initial stimulus to final realisation
- \* work independently both in studio and private study time
- \* develop knowledge and understanding of Art Craft and Design
- \* relate theoretical and contextual studies to practical experience

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
