Awards achieved

Well done to all the participants who have been working hard to complete their DofE Awards over the summer holidays. If you have put evidence on eDofE it will be reviewed by Miss McCombie before your Award can be sent for verification. Once verified we will then print and distribute certificates. If you havn't heard anything about your Award please check your emails, as if we find any issues you will be emailed telling you how to rectify the problem.

Registration

Miss McCombie has busy processed most of the Bronze registrations and participants will have received an email from DofE with their eDofE log in details. There will also be a meeting after school on Thursday 28th September to help get new participants started.

Registration for Year 10 students to start their Silver Award is now open, the deadline is at the start of October. Information has been emailed to students and parents.

Year 12 students will receive an email soon with details about how to register.

Completing DofE Awards

Last term, lots of participants completed their Expedition section. However, the expedition section is only one quarter of a DofE Award. In order to complete their Award, participants must also complete volunteering, physical activity and learning a skill. Each section must have a report written by an assessor at the end of timescale, which must then be uploaded to the participants eDofE account. If participants are having any problems with completing their Award, please contact Miss McCombie.

Please remember that program plans need to be entered into eDofE for approval before starting the activity. Once the required time has passed, assessors need to write an assessor report which needs to be uploaded as evidence to eDofE. This can be done at <u>www.dofe.org/assessor</u>

eDofE App

Participants can access their eDofE account via the DofE App. Participants can now set their activities, record evidence and submit programmes for approval at any time, no matter where they are. The DofE App is currently available for participants to download on Android and iOS. You can download the App by going to the Google Play Store or Apple App Store and searching 'The Duke of Edinburgh's Award'.

Open expeditions

If your child is unable to attend the school organised expeditions, then they can join an open expedition run by an Approved Activity Provider (AAP). The United Kingdom Health Security Agency (UKHSA) have recently published a press release following a national increase in the number of measles cases. UKHSA is urging parents of young children, teenagers and adults to check they are up to date with their MMR vaccines. Children are offered the first vaccination at 1 year and the second dose at 3 years and 4 months.

Everyone is encouraged to check their vaccination status. You can do this by checking in your NHS app if you have access to this or contact the GP practice. If anyone has missed one or both doses of

the MMR vaccine, contact the GP practice to book an appointment. It is never too late to catch up. Parents/Carers can check if their child is up to date with their MMR vaccines, by looking in the child's personal child health record (PCHR), known as the <u>red book</u>.

Symptoms of measles

Measles usually starts with cold like symptoms e.g., a high temperature, blocked or runny nose, sneezing, cough, red, sore watery eyes Other symptoms: Small white spots in mouth Measles rash (red and blotchy) which usually appears a few days after the cold like symptoms starting on face and behind ears then spreading to rest of the body. Anyone displaying symptoms should consult the GP or NHS 111

Anyone with symptoms should not return to the setting, school, nursery etc. for at least 4 days from when the rash first appears and avoid close contact with babies, pregnant women and people with a weakened immune system.

Close contacts of cases that have not had 2 doses of MMR may be required to stay away from work, depending on their role, for up to 21 days.

Pregnant women who come into contact with measles should seek medical advice from their midwife or GP as soon as possible.
