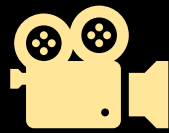

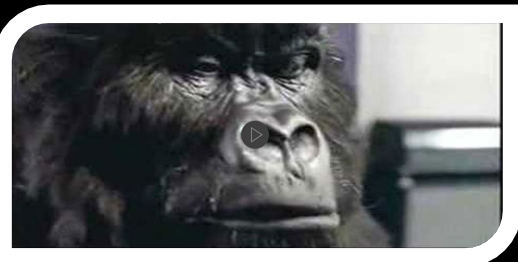


Lesson 1 Identify interesting camera angles

Lesson 2 Video file formats

AVI - Video and audio no compression large file sizes
Mov - Apple format used on web - supports compression.
WMV - windows media file - web compatible
MP4 - common format used for web streaming

Lesson 3/4 Planning a video?

Footage: Video/images to be used in your project

Rough cut: Video footage that had been assembled but not edited

Storyboard - a layout of how your end piece will look like in sequence. It may have script/ text inserted to show detail of what will be included

Project files
Can be video/images
Sound files, Title files
Dragged onto the timelines

Timelines
Contain footage,
video/images
Text slides
Sound files

Title files
Used as text to introduce a scene. Created using the title menu and dropped onto a timeline

Timeline
used to layer footage and sound in sequence

Right click on a clip to gain access to more editing options.

Transitions
These show as blue on the timeline. They are used to smooth between clips
