Theme 2 (Building a Business):

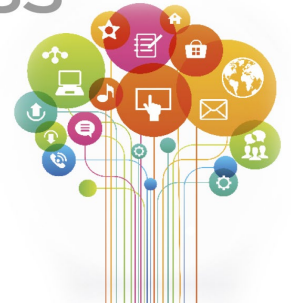
- Growing the business.
