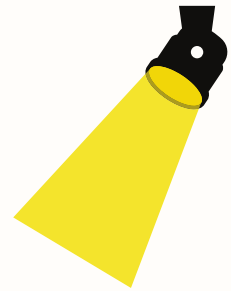
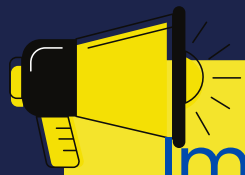

Enjoy the sunshine this weekend, and thank you all for your continued hard work and dedication.

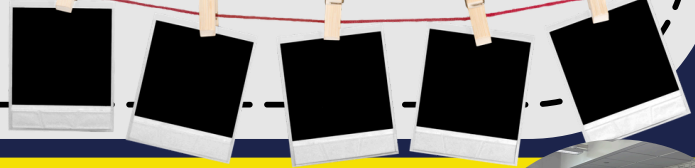
Looking ahead, next week brings the final preparations for our Summer Fair, which promises to be a brilliant event for our school community.

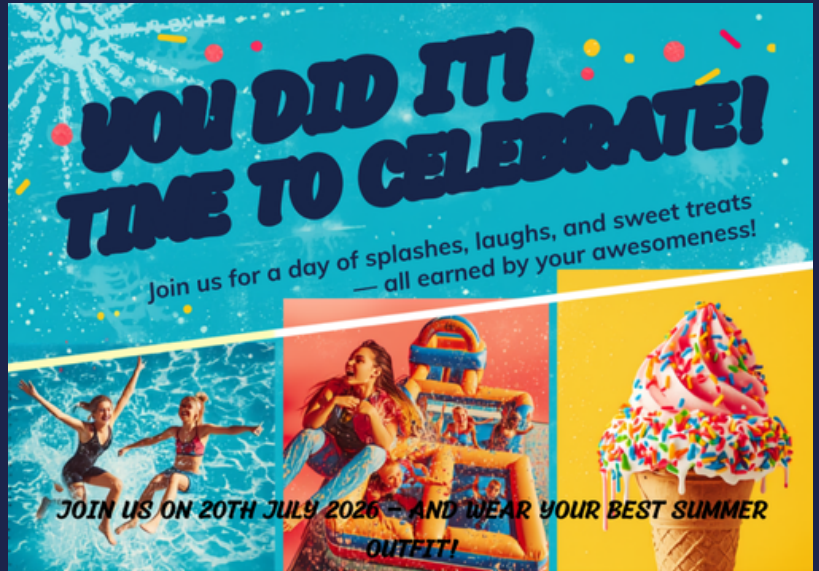
REWARDS

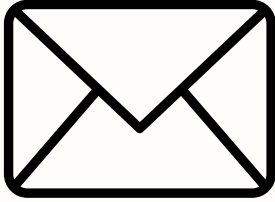

Head Teacher Letter

Dear WBS Families

I am writing to inform you that we will be carrying out a planned lockdown practice at school on the afternoon of Monday 13th July at approximately 2.45pm.
